All of the images entered must be 'as seen', so no post processing is allowed except for cropping and we will only be allowing 2 images of the set to be in Mono form this time.

Please submit images in accordance with the usual club specifications ...resize 1600 x 1200, jpeg format and sRGB colour space and 300dpi. (Please see the club's website for details of how to do this or ask a member for help if you need to)

Please label with your membership number followed by letter A - J the first 5 images are categories A - E as

So for example For member 99, the first image must be labelled as follows...

099_A_Street food

And the second image

099 B Something old

And so on to E.

Images F to J would be labelled for example....

099_F_your own title

Please do title your own choice images as this saves them from getting muddled up like they have before, and please note the underscore!!

Our judging will be on each image entered and will receive a score out of 20. We will give a bonus point to each of the top five images that catch our eye the most. We request that you enter your images no later than 13th November 2025 and send them to the usual club competitions email address, as we need some time to look at them before the competition night in December.

Members please remember you don't have to do this all on one specific day or time of the day, you can go as often as you like to get your images and could go at different times of the day, you could even team up with other members and car share if you wish to.
